Dr. Antonio Raymo made a presentation about the status of projects/planning and fund commitments of Measure GG Bond funds. A discussion by the Committee ensued.

**Agenda Item # 7 – Discussion of Potential Committee Recommendations to District**

Edwin Van Ginkel facilitated a discussion of the Committee members regarding potential recommendations to the District. In its discussion, Committee members preliminarily identified the following school sites for further study as potential sites for alternative use and revenue generation: Morningside HS complex; Inglewood HS; Kelso ES; Oak Street ES; Bennett-Kew ES; Worthington ES; and Warren Lane ES. The Committee requested further analysis be performed by the District and be presented to the Committee regarding possible reconfiguration to a K-8 program for all middle school students and reconfiguration to a single comprehensive high school of a capacity of not more than 2,000 students or two smaller special curriculum focused high schools of approximately 1,000 student capacity each. Mr. Van Ginkel suggested that the next Advisory Committee meeting should take place no sooner than Thursday, June 8, 2017 so further analysis could be performed regarding the Committees' request for additional information.
