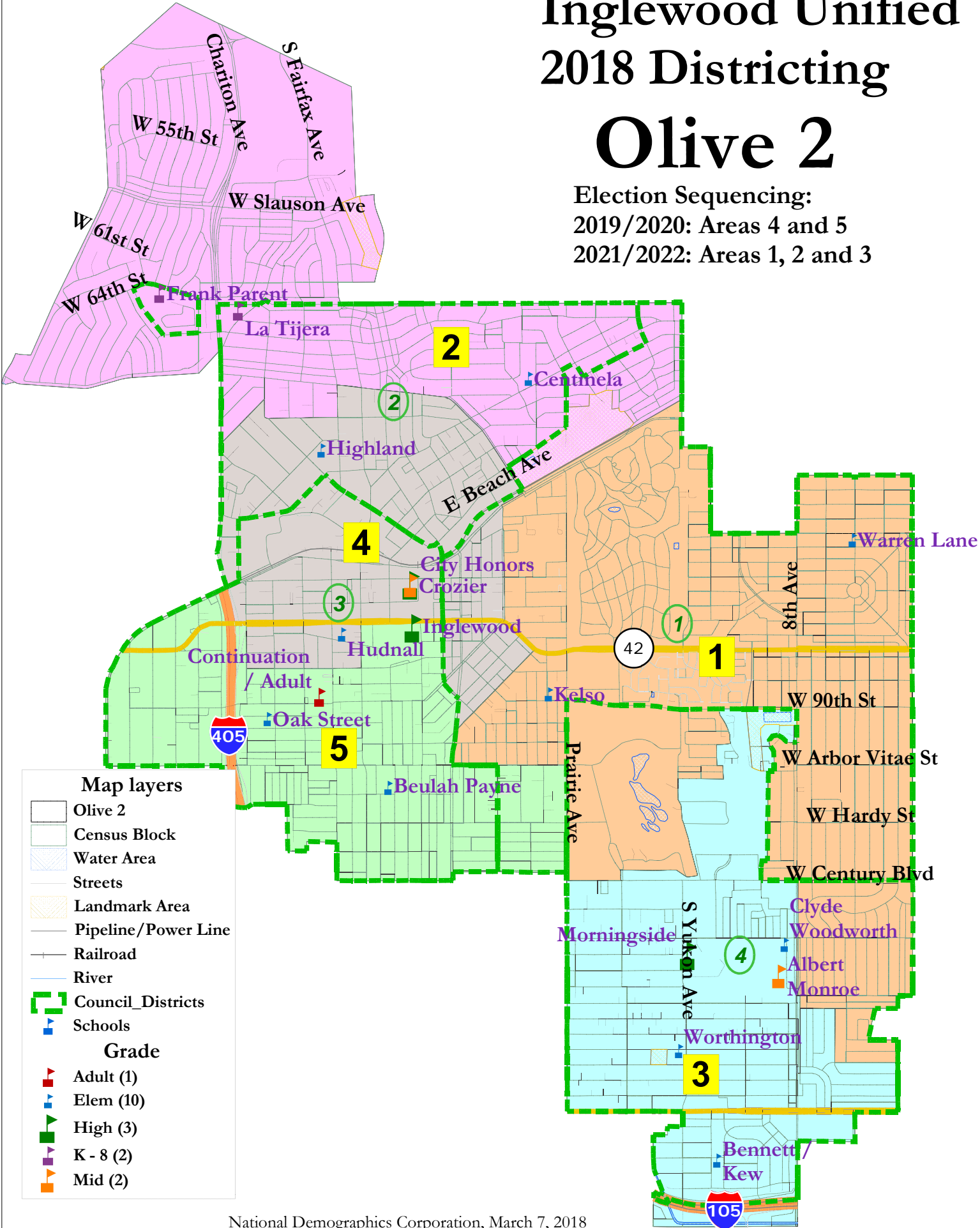


# Inglewood Unified 2018 Districting Olive 2
