Notice is hereby given that the Maintenance Department of the Inglewood Unified School District is requesting a quote/proposal for professional services, to be received by electronic mail no later than April 10, 2018, 1:00 p.m. local time for the following scope of work:

SCOPE OF WORK:

Asphalt paving at Morningside High School consisting of complete removal, hauling and replacement of asphalt with engineering to correct elevations. The installation will be a design section consisting of 3" asphalt over 4" class II base. Installation of new concrete v-gutter approximately 572 lineal feet x 3 feet wide, restripe parking lot per existing configuration to include ADA compliance, speed bumps and wheel stops. Design, furnish and install one pair of 2" diameter galvanized tubing folding swing gates for a total span of 26 feet (Two (2) at 13 feet each extended) with posts as required to maintain minimum 24 foot wide Fire Vehicle access.
